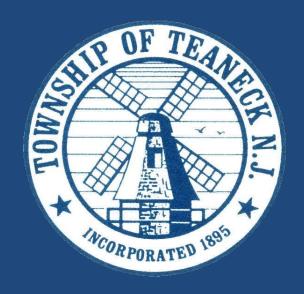

#### Assumptions

#### 2013 Budget is dependent upon:

- Council determination of 2013 Municipal Budget Appropriations
- Fund Balance (Surplus) available for 2013
- 2012 Municipal Revenues' Analysis and 2013 Revenue Anticipations
- State Aid allocations for 2013
- Receipt of Municipal Information Sheet issued by Division of Local Government Services
- BCUA Sewer Increase estimated at 5.99%

#### Factors impacting budget

- General state of economy
- Impact of tax appeals
- Ratable Base
- Interest rates
- Reduced or flat state aid
- BCUA sewer

# Budget Timeline January 17, 2013 Meeting

- Reviewed Police Department budget including authorized strength, potential consolidation of dispatch, and Police Overtime
- 2. Reviewed Public Works/Engineering budgets including vacancies, temporary employees, costs associated with sewer cameras, budgeting for tree-trimming, and moneys spent on contracted engineering services

## Budget Timeline January 17, 2013 Meeting

3. Reviewed – Capital Budget and discussed road resurfacing, Rodda Center replacement doors, and the Turf Field Project at Votee Park

### Budget Timeline January 24, 2013 Meeting

- 1. Reviewed Legal Services budget
- 2. Reviewed Fire Department budget including salary and wages, overtime, and capital.
- 3. Reviewed Recreation Department budget including proposed new software

## Budget Timeline January 24, 2013 Meeting

- 4. Reviewed Various budget accounts, including Group Insurance, BCUA
- Also discussed:
  - Revenue estimates
  - Assessment of Property Taxes

## Budget Timeline January 24<sup>th</sup> Budget Packet Issued

- Budget packet issued to Council on January 24<sup>th</sup> with requested documents from prior budget meetings including the following:
  - Police Overtime expenditures for Court
     Sessions
  - Hurricane Irene Expenditures
  - Estimated Hurricane Sandy Overtime Expenditures

## Budget Timeline January 31, 2013 Meeting

- 1. Presentation Auditor
- 2. Presentation Insurance
- 3. Reviewed Township Library's budget Reduced by \$1,000 due to insurance
- 4. Reviewed Council's budget
- 5. Reviewed Township Manager's budget
- 6. Reviewed Township Clerk's budget, including agenda preparation software

## Budget Timeline February 28, 2013 Memorandum

 February 28, 2013 – Issued memorandum to Council on the following:

- -Tax Appeal Judgment Refunding
- -BCUA reduction in assessment

Tax Appeal Judgment Refunding :

January 7, 2013 received 1,800 judgment notices
 from County Tax Board totaling \$2,212,920.32

Received after year tax owed

Prior year's taxes owed in current year

Options:

Appropriate total in 2013 budget creating significant tax increase or deficit

 Apply to Local Finance Board to issue Refunding Bonds

- Actions to be taken:
- Emergency Temporary Appropriation (Resolution L)

 Appropriates \$2,212,920.32 in 2013 budget to pay refunds

 Apply to Local Finance Board on April 10, 2013 for authorization to issue equivalent amount in refunding bonds to be paid over 3 years

- Actions to be taken:
- Emergency Temporary Appropriation (Resolution L)
  - If approved, approximately \$740,000 will be added to 2013, 2014, 2015 budgets (2013 budget amendment)
  - If application not approved, total amount will be included in 2013 budget
  - Application will require Council to commit to 2015 revaluation

Additional actions to be taken:

- Increase 2013 Tax Appeal Reserve by \$400,000 to total of 1 million
- BCUA Anticipated Assessment reduced for 2013 by \$400,000

- Council amendments to budget
- 6 Year Capital Plan (Sheet 40b)
- Final revenue
- Introduction of budget on March 19, 2013
- Final tax levy
- Adoption April 23, 2013
